For content you want to suddenly appear

Effect.Appear

For content you want to suddenly disappear

Effect.BlindUp
Effect.DropOut
Effect.Fade
Effect.Fold
Effect.Puff
Effect.Shrink
Effect.SlideUp

Toggling Effects ON/OFF

Pairs *BlindUp/BlindDown*, *Appear/Fade*, and *SlideUp/SlideDown* for reusable toggle effects

`Effect.toggle('elmntid','blind OR appear OR slide');`

↑
"toggle" must be lowercase.
